
Member News

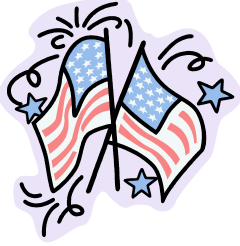
